Museums and other attractions

Wahlberg's House - The Uusikaupunki museum

Ylinenkatu 11. Opening hours: to Aug 25: Mon-Fri 10am-5pm, Sat-Sun 12-3pm. At other times Tue-Fri 12-3pm or at other times by agreement. Groups by appointment. Guided tours on summer Thursdays at 2 pm.

A handsome bourgeois house, previously owned by a tobacco factory owner, provides insight into life in the 19th century. Maritime section upstairs. Guided tours on summer Thursdays at 2pm. The main exhibition on display from the beginning of the summer to the end of October 2019 explores the position and life of children in Uusikaupunki in the beginning of the 20th century. Children are also taken into account. They can play detectives in the museum and do different tasks related to the exhibition. During the summer, a separate play area for children will be opened in the outbuilding.

Tickets: Adults EUR 5 (price includes Naval Pilot Museum and Sailor's Home Museum), free admission for people under the age of 18.

Group ticket: EUR 3 per person (minimum group size 10 people).

Guided tours: EUR 40 per group or EUR 60 per group (maximum group size

25 people) outside opening hours (advance booking required). Free admission with Museum Card.

Naval Pilot Museum and Seilor's Home Museum, open June 24 – August 11 at 12 noon to 3 pm.

Entrance fee: 2 € / adult, children under 18 free. Joint ticket 5 € / adult (incl. Wahlberg House, Pilot Museum and Seilor's Home Museum). Free admission with museum card.

Introduction fee 30 € / group, outside opening hours 40 € / group (always book in advance).

Naval Pilot Museum

Mäyhälänkatu 2B, Uusikaupunki. The former Uusikaupunki pilot station on the Vallimäki park has been a small summer museum on the profession of pilots this summer for 50 years. The two-room building displays the original equipment of the pilot station and information on the demanding profession of the pilot.



Seilor's Home Museum

Myllykatu 20, Uusikaupunki. The Seamen's Home Museum is located on the edge of Myllymäki in a building that is one of the oldest preserved residential buildings in Uusikaupunki. The house have been built in the 1770s. The small house is decorated to depict the home of a New Town sailor family from the early 20th century. In the summer you can wash in the yard. Laundry by old methods or even walking on wooden legs. Indoors, you can play as a detective!



Uusikaupunki Automobile Museum

Autotehtaankatu 11, Uusikaupunki. Opening hours: Jun-Aug: daily 10 am-6 pm;

Sep-May: daily 11 am-7 pm. There are more than 100 vehicles in three large

exhibition halls, including the largest Saab collection in the world, old

motorbikes and mopeds as well as two aeroplanes and a garage museum.

Uusikaupunki Maritime centre

Pakkahuoneentori 1, open to August 18, Tue to Sat at 10 am to 7 pm.

The Maritime centre exhibits a wide variety of maritime historical sights. The main exhibition includes: several old boat engines, a large miniature model of barque Warma, maritime paintings, etc. Free admission to the exhibition.

Churches

The Uusikaupunki and The Pyhämaa churches are open from June 3 to August 11 Mon-Sat at 11 am to 5 pm and Sun 12 noon to 4 pm. All churches in Uusikaupunki and Pyhämaa are road churches.

Uusikaupunki New Church, Rauhankatu 1 c. A Gothic style church dating from 1863.



Uusikaupunki Old Church, Alinenkatu 44. This grey granite church with its vaulted ceiling is located in the centre of Uusikaupunki. Dating from 1629, it is the city's oldest building. Next to the church there is an ancient graveyard and soldiers' graves.

Pyhämaa Old Church ("Uhrikirkko")

Kirkontaukantie 15, in the Pyhämaa village. Unique wooden church from the early 17th century. The ceiling and interior walls are completely covered in frescoes.



Pyhämaa New Church

Kirkontaustantie 15, Pyhämaa. A Grey granite church dating from 1804, located next to the Pyhämaa Old Church. Altarpiece by Arvid Liljelund.

Cultural History Walk -brochure

The Tourist Office provides a brochure on the Cultural History Walk, which allows you to explore the history and sights of the city on your own. The cultural walk is a four-kilometer-long historic walking trail along which most of the downtown tourist attractions are located. In the brochure you can find a map and a short description of 33 different sights. *Enjoy your tour!*



Go outside and explore Uusikaupunki - Find the hidden statues!

Hidden Play is a series of small bronze sculptures hidden in the terrain that can be searched for using a digital or printed map. Each route comes with a mobile game that helps you look at the environment from different angles and learn new things. The search is free of charge for the participants. Hidden Play is a combination of community art and treasure hunting games (eg geocaching). Young people have made statues at workshops, brainstormed and planned a route.

The route is suitable for everyone: residents, school classes, seniors, work groups, tourists, etc. The route is about 4-5 km long. You can search for hidden play sculptures at: <https://piiloleikki.fi/kartta/>

Happy chairs - Ilossi Tualei

Happy and colourful chairs will dot the streets in the town centre during the summer. The chairs of the Ilossi Tualei project are meant to be sat on, admired, wondered at and of course also photographed. There are about 200 chairs around the city center. Chair-themed postcards will be available, and proceeds will go towards good and necessary causes.



Welhovesi ring route

Cycling routes in the northern archipelago in Uusikaupunki. The main route is 50 kilometres long. Accommodation, food services, scenic resting places with stories of local history, as well as beaches and direct sale available. You can rent bikes (also e-bikes) from Tourist Information Office, Rauhankatu 10.


